Praised for his warm sound and high musicality, this collaborative musician is involved in many relevant jazz groups and is also active in the field of chanson, in his home area of Lyon as well as around France. Musical encounters have had a fundamental importance in his personal development from the beginning of his professional career some twenty years ago. At first with the well known Arfi collective as a listener, then as a musician himself being nowadays a member of the famous Workshop de Lyon. To name a few of his main current projects: Possible(s) quartet ; MCR (Maimone-Cohen-Roudet) ; Contrebrassens (A show based around George Brassens) ; Grand Impérial Orchestra (GRIO) the outstanding octet from the Compagnie Impérial.
